Information for Candidates

1.1 The Ganga Medical centre and Hospital entrance exam for the orthopedic regional anaesthesia and trauma critical care fellowship programs for the academic year 2024 is an online exam

1.2 The exam can be attended from your place of convenience (home / workplace) provided the necessary criteria for online exam is met

1.3 All the eligible candidates must appear for the exam using the electronic device advised by our exam partner

1.4 A mock exam will be conducted a week prior to the main exam for the candidates to get oriented with the exam interface, login process and answering the questions

1.5 The online exam will be human proctored, and any candidate found doing malpractices will be disqualified from the exam

1.6 The online exam will be a multiple-choice questions and no negative markings will be awarded

1.7 The entrance exam is common for all the fellowship programme for the academic year 2024 and seat allotment will be based upon the merit

1.8 All the selected candidates must have completed PG in anaesthesia with a provisional / permanent degree (DA., MD., DNB). Candidates who doesn't hold a degree before the course commencement will not be taken into the fellowship program. The upper age limit for the candidates is 40 as on June 30th ,2023

1.9 The seat allotment will be done through the counselling conducted via virtual meeting and the shortlisted candidates have to attend the counselling without fail

1.10 There will be no extension of the application window period and candidates who fail to submit the application / do the payment will not be entertained later

1.11 After the application window closure, an official WhatsApp group will be formed for sharing updates regarding the exam to the candidates

1.12 The Department of anaesthesiology and critical care along with the hospital administration hold all the rights in conducting the exam and candidate selection.

STIPEND DETAILS

EXAM DETAILS

2.1 The entrance exam will be a multiple-choice question with a single correct response

2.2 There will be no negative markings

2.3 Total number of questions will be 60

2.4 Total duration allowed is 60 minutes excluding the logging into the exam interface and verifying identity

2.5 All candidates must show a valid GOVT Identity card having the photograph of the candidate to the proctor for verification during the login process

2.6 All the candidates should check their electronic gadget suitability for the exam during mock test and the same device should be used for main exam

2.7 Candidates will be given with dos and don'ts for the exam along with the login credentials. Candidates have to strictly adhere to them and failing which will lead to disqualification

2.8 Laptop/PC with enough battery backup with a stable internet connection (Min 1 Mbps) during the exam is mandatory

2.9 The exam will be auto submitted once the time is over

2.10 Single click on the question will enlarge the image

2.11 No breaks are allowed during the exam

2.12 Use of any other gadgets like mobile phone, Bluetooth devices, headphone / earphones are not allowed

2.13 System requirement – Laptop / PC with windows 7 & above with a webcam enabled. The microphone of the system should be enabled

2.14 Don't try to toggle between browser / windows during the exam which will lead nullification of the exam

2.15 If any technical fault arises at the candidate end the hotline number should be contacted for support, however there wont be any extra time provided for the lost
